

PATRICK CONVEY RECOGNITION AWARD

The Patrick Convey Recognition Award fund was established to celebrate and remember the life of Patrick Convey by supporting an annual award to Nova Scotia rowing athletes and others involved in the sport of rowing who best exemplify the traits that made Patrick a special person. Specifically, a person with a passion for sharing his gifts, a commitment to rowing in Nova Scotia and an athletic achievement in rowing.

We accept self-nominations and nominations of athletes, coaches and others involved in the sport of rowing. That means individuals can apply for themselves or nominate someone who they feel meets our criteria.

Our award recognizes both youth and older athletes and the differing life experience and rowing resumes. We have 2 categories based on age: Category 1 is open to those age 25 years or younger; Category 2 is open to those age 26 years and older

Past applicants and past recipients are welcome to reapply.

The Award amount for 2017 is \$1500 for each Award Recipient.

Criteria

- NS resident and NS rowing club member at point of application – principle is to consider an individual who is giving back to NS rowing to promote the sport in NS
- Athlete performance – athlete who is working to capacity, has set rowing goals and demonstrates a passion for rowing
- Coaches and others involved in rowing – the individual contributes to rowing through various activities such as coaching, sport promotion, volunteer work at regattas, and or participating in club activities
- Personal qualities – demonstrates good sportsmanship, integrity, commitment to rowing and to NS rowing, general attitude, active willingness to help others (as confirmed by at least 2 references, including 1 from a club president, head coach, or designate)

Applicants/Nominees:

- Registered members of a Canadian Rowing Club and member of Rowing Canada Aviron
- Rowing Nova Scotia club membership
- Coach in good standing as confirmed by club president or RowNS

References (Written):

- 1-character reference and 1-club reference - ensure reference letters includes telephone and email contact information of the referee

Submission Process:

1. **Complete** your typed application or nomination using the format provided
2. **Attach** written references to the application or nomination
3. **Submit** applications/nominations online to Row NS office by **midnight September 18, 2017**, at rowing@rowns.ca
