

LYC ROWING 2025 ROWING COACH

LYC Rowing, located at the Lunenburg Yacht Club just outside Lunenburg, Nova Scotia on the shores of Mahone Bay, is seeking applications for a Rowing Coach to support its 2025 recreational rowing program. Come and spend your summer on the beautiful waters of Mahone Bay!

Rowing Coach: full-time (30-35 hours / week) July-August 2025 with possible opportunity to work part-time in late June and early September. \$18.50/hour.

The Coach is responsible for generally overseeing the safe operation of recreational coastal rowing programs. These programs include masters rowing, adult novice rowing, and a new Junior Rowing program. The coach works closely with the members of the Rowing Club.

Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Maintaining, supporting and coaching participants in the Masters Recreational Rowing program, including leading scheduled practice sessions and running the safety boat.
- 2. Overseeing and supporting a new Junior Rowing Program.
- 3. Supporting the Adult Novice Rowing program as required.
- 4. Assisting with program administration, promotion, and equipment and facility maintenance.
- 5. Assisting with "learn to row" and mentoring sessions for new and novice rowers
- 6. Assisting with various rowing events hosted by the club such as rows for visiting rowers from other clubs, rowing tours, etc.

Required - Skills and experience as an athlete and/or coach in organized sport, and:

- Prior experience in organizing athletic events and activities
- On-the-water athletic and safety experience; eg, rowing, paddling, sailing
- Current Emergency First Aid/CPR certification
- Pleasure Craft Operators Card
- Well-developed interpersonal, organizational, communication, and leadership skills
- For candidates over the age of 18, a clear Vulnerable Persons and Criminal Records Check.

Preference will be given to applicants with on-water rowing experience and a coaching certification for rowing, e.g. the Learn-to-Row (LTR) Coach course. LYC Rowing may cover the costs of the LTR Coach Course, and other certification costs, for the successful candidate. Applicants with paddling and/or sailing experience, and relevant coaching/training experience, may also be considered.
